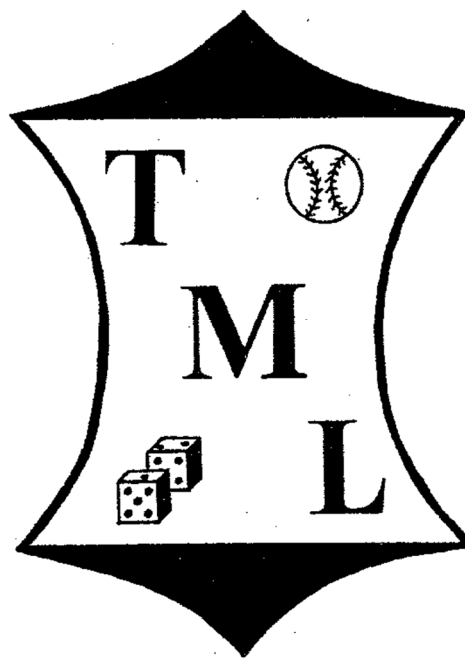

Jimmie Foxx became only the 2nd player in TML History to win the Triple Crown, joining Eddie Murray in 1985. Foxx also set all time single season TML Records for AVG (.429), RBI (232), TB (512), RC (271) and RC/27 (19.3), while leading the league in many other categories! Foxx is now the Career SLG leader at .674. Cecil Travis set a new single season TML Record for HBP (64)! Ouch!

For the 2nd straight season Arkansas set all time team TML Records for AVG (.344), SLG (.563), Runs (1352), Hits (1998) and RBI (1307), as well as tying the TML Record for Sac Flys (85). Oakdale set a dubious team pitching TML Record for most Hits allowed (1963).

The longest winning streak of 14 games was done by Summer (5/8-5/24) and the longest losing streak of 17 games was by Oakdale (7/28-8/25).

Bryan Sakolsky's Walla Walla Wombats outlasted Willie Jelks's defending TML Champs Arkansas Travelers in a wild 7 games loaded with offense! It was the 3rd TML Championship for the franchise but 9th for Bryan! Both teams scored 58 runs in the 7 games, with a 13-12 G-7 finale in which Walla Walla hung on as Arkansas rallied for 7 runs in the 9th! Both teams had advanced to the TML World series in a short 5 games, Walla Walla over Beverly and Arkansas over Summer. Walla Walla Co-Playoff MVPs Hal Trosky (.418, 10 R, 21 RBI, 4 HR, 11 EXBH) and Bob Johnson (.333, 15 R, 17 RBI, 7 HR, 9 EXBH) led the way!

Seven of the 8 regulars slugged OVER .500, four of whom slugged over ,600! While Travs will no doubt never match this output, the offense looks pretty nifty for years to come.

The late inning law firm of DeShong, Tietje, and Wagner were available, blowing 23 saves while holding only 19. Wagner led in billable hours, blowing 11 of 17 save opportunities.

The Season Story

The Season Story

An 84-70 season wasn't bad but three other Atmospheric opponents did better. The emergence of Jeff Heath as the offense leader was the singular best performance by a Crusher in 1938. Heath's slash line of 394/423/692 was a shade better than perennial batting leader Frank McCormick who was winding down as the Sonoma bat leader at 318/347/507. Mound-wise the Crushers produced four double figure winners in Bob Weiland (16-12), Paul Derringer (14-11), Jim Bagby (13-12) and Bob Poffenberger (11-6). Prospects for 1937 are mediocre at best with a descent to crumby in 1936 with major rebuilding being a major challenge into the 1920s.
